By way of moving this petition, the petitioner Gurnam Singh @ Sardara an accused in FIR No. 20 dated 15.12.2016 for offence under Section 21/25/29 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station SSOC, Amritsar, prays for grant of interim bail to attend the marriage of his son which is fixed for 20.01.2018 at Royal Garden, Village Gandiwind, Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Rakeshinder Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

As per allegations, the contraband recovered from the petitioner was 5 Kg of heroin, which amounts to commercial quantity and in view of bar under Section 37 IPC, bail cannot be granted to the petitioner.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that marriage of real son of the petitioner is to be performed, it is directed that petitioner be taken to venue for Shagun Ceremony and marriage functions on 20.01.2018 and 21.01.2018 in police custody. Necessary arrangements be made to ensure that he does not try to escape.

However, the expenses for transportation and escort shall be determined by Superintendent of the jail concerned and the same be got deposited before taking the petitioner to the venue of functions by the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of.
