Reply by way of affidavit of Navreet Singh Virk, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar on behalf of respondent(s)-State has been filed. Same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.83 dated 05.08.2017, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Roop Nagar.

The allegations against the petitioner is he alongwith his associates interfered the property of the Panchayat and caused injuries to the complainant party. Lateron two of the injuries were found grievous.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more

required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 07.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
