This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of order dated 06.05.2017 passed in Complaint Case No.86/13 dated 06.12.2013 titled as “Luxmi Devi versus Sandeep and others” whereby evidence of the petitioner was closed.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter, pursuant to which appearance has been caused on behalf of respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents herein informed this court that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous, on account of the fact that the aforesaid main case already stands dismissed.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner to deny the averments that have been made, despite the fact that learned counsel for

the petitioner herein was present before this court in an earlier matter.
