The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No. 82 dated 14.07.2015 registered under Sections 498-A IPC, Women Police Station, District Ludhiana and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of written compromise arrived at between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioner says that the complainant was represented through her mother who is the Special Power of Attorney and the Special Power of Attorney has been placed on record.

Counsel for respondent no.2 says that complainant - Parminder Kaur was in India when the Special Power of Attorney was executed.

Report has been received from the trial Court after statements of the petitioner and the Special Power of Attorney were recorded regarding the compromise. The trial Court has reported that the compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion. The trial Court has also sent copy of the statements of parties.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that petitioner is the only accused and respondent no.2 is the only aggrieved person in this FIR.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements and report of the trial Court and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed qua the petitioners.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
