The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Criminal Complaint No.6616 of 03.06.2016, in which the petitioner has been summoned under Sections 366, 376, 506, 201 of Indian Penal Code, by the court of Ld. JMIC, Chandigarh vide order dated 15.06.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that, pursuant to the directions given by this order by an order dated 25.05.2017, the petitioner herein has surrendered before the summoning court and furnished the bail bonds and has been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the

summoning court.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has surrendered before the summoning court and has been released on interim bail, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 25.05.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
