This is an application for grant of regular bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in FIR No. 4 dated 13.1.2018 registered under Sections 22, 61 and 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 (for short 'the NDPS Act') at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar (Punjab).

Admittedly, the commercial quantity of 15 injections Buprenorphine each weighing 2 ML was recovered from the petitioner on 13.1.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that compliance of Section 50 of the NDPS Act was not done.
