Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing complaint No.6595 of 2013, dated 06.12.2013 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 506/452/382/447/427/148/149 IPC at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 30.03.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 04.05.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 29.05.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Kapurthala, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.1719, dated 21.07.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, vide Endst. No.1310, dated 26.07.2018.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class,

Kapurthala, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is

will.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Kapurthala, dated 21.07.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid complaint No.6595 of 2013, dated 06.12.2013 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
