Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.213 dated 30.12.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.

The allegation against the petitioners is that they have obtained loan for an amount of Rs.8.5 lacs by mortgaging the land which was already subject matter of mortgage with some other bank.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 13.06.2018 of this Court, the petitioners have deposited about

Rs.6,00,000/- and are ready to pay the balance amount within three months from today.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Subhash Chand, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have already deposited about Rs.6,00,000/- and are ready to pay the balance amount within three months from today, the petitioners deserve to be admitted on bail.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.

It is made clear that in case the petitioners fail to pay the outstanding within three months, the prosecution will be at liberty to seek revival of this petition.

The petition stands disposed of.
