Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') in case FIR No. 545 dated 01.08.2016 under 379-B of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Hansi District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial lock up for the last about 01 year and 6 months and till date, no evidence has been recorded. It is further submitted that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant-Satish Kumar.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has not disputed this fact.

Learned State counsel, however, on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar, has opposed the prayer for regular bail on the ground that the petitioner is involved in two more FIRs.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial lock up for the last about 01 year and 06 months; no evidence has been recorded so far and the complainant has acknowledged that there is a compromise between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.
