ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.105 dated 25.07.2017, registered under Sections 306/34 of IPC Act at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is the Jeth and was married 10 years prior to the marriage of the deceased with Jaswinder Singh and they are residing separately. Counsel urges that the deceased was married to Jaswinder Singh 12 years ago and Jaswinder Singh had gone to Saudi Arabia 2.5 years ago. Counsel states that the family had given the call details which show that on the fateful day, the deceased had spoken on mobile phone which is registered in the name of Gurcharan Singh. Counsel further states that the call details are in the police file but they have not made any investigation and have arrested the petitioner. It was

urged that the call record would show that the deceased had spoken to Gurcharan Singh and there are 3 calls before she committed suicide. The counsel also refers to the FIR and urges that the complainant had mentioned in the complaint that her daughter were residing in a separate house for the last 6 years.

Investigation is over. Challan has been presented. 3 witnesses have already been examined as referred in the order of the Court below.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
