Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the FIR has been registered alleging therein the commission of offence punishable under Section 307 of IPC also, no injury whatsoever having been attributed to the petitioner, Raghbir Singh, in the occurrence, with him also infact not named in the FIR.

That being so, which factually of course could not be refuted by learned State counsel even on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh and the petitioner having been in custody for 2 months now, as per the custody certificate filed in Court today by the learned State counsel, in the aforesaid circumstances the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
