GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.126 dated 26.02.2017, registered under Sections 420, 406, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Saran, Faridabad, District Faridabad, and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the ground that matter has since been compromised amongst the parties.

Vide order dated 14.05.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Illaqa Magistrate, Faridabad so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate has been received to the effect that the statements of complainant Deepak Kumar and also of the accused/petitioner Mukeem Khan have been recorded to the effect that they

have compromised the matter amongst themselves. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad has opined that the parties have compromised the matter voluntarily without there being any threat or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in **2007(3) RCR (CrI.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab**, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.126 dated 26.02.2017, registered under Sections 420, 406, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Saran, Faridabad, District Faridabad, and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
