The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.99 Dated 13.5.2017, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Kotwali, District Kapurthala.

The allegations, in nutshell, are that on 13.5.2017 when the complainant was sleeping in his house along with other members of his family, then the applicants-petitioners along with some other co-accused who were all armed with baseball bats and sticks entered their house after scaling wall and caused injuries to the complainant on his shoulder and on right side of his chin. It is further alleged that the wife of the complainant was also given a '*dang* blow' on her chest as well as on her right elbow. When complainant's brother Satnam Singh raised alarm then Varinder Singh, Sandeep Singh and Charanjit Kaur also came to their house and who were also caused injuries.

Notice of this application had been issued to the State and the petitioners had been ordered to be released on interim bail.

Today at the very outset, Mr. A.S. Sandhu, Addl. A.G. Punjab assisted by ASI Manjit Singh has stated that the petitioners have since joined the investigation and are no longer required for any further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid position and also the fact that the petitioners have already joined investigation and there being nothing to suggest that custodial interrogation is required, the present petition is hereby accepted and the interim directions made by this Court vide order dated 24.5.2018 are hereby made absolute.
