Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition but a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously and some order regarding exemption from personal appearance of the petitioners be passed.

Heard.

Allowed.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, however, the trial Court is directed to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial within 6 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in that Court by giving short adjournments and State is also directed to cause appearance of PWs in the Court on each and every date of hearing. It is directed that after the petitioner-accused put in appearance in the trial Court and move an application for exempting their personal appearance, the trial Court would exempt personal appearance of these petitioners subject to the condition that

they would be represented by their counsel, their identity shall not be disputed, and no adjournment shall be sought for the reason of their identification. The trial Court may direct them to appear in the Court, if their appearance is found to be necessary.
