GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.50 dated 1.5.2007 registered under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Mehna, District Moga and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 7.5.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Moga has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners and also of respondents No.2 and 3 namely Nachattar Singh and Surjit Kaur have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and that the complainant Nachattar Singh and Surjit Kaur have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed. It has specifically been opined that

the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and free from any duress or inducement.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.50 dated 1.5.2007 registered under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Mehna, District Moga and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
