Petitioners have approached this Court with the grievance of petitioner No.1 that no action taken on her complaint with regard to the missing report of her husband-Nitin Sharma @ Amit. Another grievance which has been pointed out is that as per the police authorities husband of the petitioner is wanted in some criminal case and the whole family, that is, the petitioners' are being harassed and made to sit in the police station from morning till evening. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioners have been cooperating with the matter, however the petitioners are being unnecessarily harassed. In any case the counsel contends that the petitioners are not averse to joining any inquiry proceedings but proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. is required to be given to them before calling them for any inquiry, if any.

In the light of the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioners, in case petitioners are required for any inquiry etc. by

respondents No. 3 to 5, they shall be given proper notice under Section 160 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

Petition stands disposed of with the above observations.
