The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 06.04.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 384, 389 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Heard.

It has been submitted that petitioner is in jail along with her two years child. Nothing has to be recovered from her. She is in custody since the date of her arrest.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Harjit Kaur @ Simarjit Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
