The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.328 dated 11.08.2017, registered under Section 136 of the Electricity Act, 2003, at Police Station Indri, District Karnal.

2. Investigation already completed and challan submitted. Co-accused, Imam Ali had been granted bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in similar circumstances on 15.12.2017 in CRM-M No.47191 of 2017.

3. The bail application is nevertheless opposed on behalf of the State on the ground that the petitioner is involved in three more cases of the same nature.

4. In the given circumstances considering the detention undergone by the petitioner whose custodial interrogation in the present case is definitely not required at this stage, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the

Ld. Trial Court with a further direction to report at the concerned Police Station once a week whenever he actually released on bail for a period of three months.
