The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.9 dated 26.01.2018, registered under Sections 379-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 482 and 411 of the IPC added later on, at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Admittedly, the FIR was lodged after a delay of 57 days and the complainant also had no previous acquaintance with the culprits.
3. Investigation already completed and challan submitted.
4. Co-accused, Sidhant Bihal was granted bail by this Court in CRM-M No.13672 of 2018 in similar circumstances on 16.04.2017.
5. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he may now also be released on regular bail on identical terms and conditions as directed in case of co-accused, Sidhant Bihal.
