Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.29 dated 14.05.2016 under Sections 307,323,148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 5 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ranger Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 07.05.2018, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court.
