This petition has been filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail in case FIR No.191 dated 01.05.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 180, 323, 302, 506, 427, 120-B IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kukrukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that role of the petitioner is at par with Lakhwinder Singh who has been granted regular bail vide order dated 14.05.2018 in CRM-M-16413 of 2018. While dismissing the bail application by the trial Court, a wrong averment has been made that case of the petitioner is different and most of the witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution whereas all these witnesses have resiled from their statements made before the trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that not only Lakhwinder Singh against whom same allegations are there but co-accused Jagmeet Singh has also been granted regular bail vide order dated 21.02.2018 passed in CRM-M-40869

of 2017. Co-accused Khushwant Singh has also been granted regular bail vide order dated 06.04.2018 passed in CRM-M No. 11385 of 2018. Co-accused Jatinder Singh @ Gora, Harmanpreet Singh and Gurpreet Singh alias Gopi have been granted bail by the Sessions Court.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner regarding grant of regular bail to the accused by this Court as well as by the Sessions Court. However, he opposes the submissions to the extent that Danda was recovered from the petitioner.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and by considering the fact that co-accused who have already been granted bail were having similar role to that of the petitioner and also the fact that most of the witnesses have not supported the case for the prosecution, the present petition is allowed and petitioner Randhir Singh alias Pola is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
