ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in a cross version recorded vide DDR No.38 dated 25.06.2011 under Sections 307/34/120-B IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur arising out of main case registered vide FIR No. 66, dated 24.06.2011, under Sections 336, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dasuya District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the afore-noted DDR are that he was standing at the place of occurrence. He was unarmed and his co-accused Sukha had fired pistol shot, which hit on right arm of the complainant and another accused. He further contends that petitioner is 26 years of age and had earlier been granted anticipatory bail. He, however, could not appear before the Court later as he was under the impression that the proceedings have been dropped against him as he was informed that in

the main case i.e FIR No.66 dated 24.06.2011 under Sections 336/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, complainant Swaran Kaur had filed an affidavit that she does not want to proceed against the accused and the trial Court had dropped the proceedings. The petitioner having been misinformed that entire proceedings have been dropped, had gone abroad and now he has been arrested on 06.04.2018 and is in custody ever since his arrest.

Learned counsel further states that he is not involved in any other case and undertakes to appear before the trial Court on each and every date and shall not absent himself except after seeking prior exemption due to unavoidable circumstances.

Heard.

The petitioner was unarmed and no role has been attributed to him except that he was standing at the place of occurrence. He is in custody for over a month and is 26 years of age. In view of the above, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Amanpreet Singh @ Bundi is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
