Petitioner-Vinod Kumar @ Boda has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.103 dated 23.12.2015, registered at Police Station Rajpura, District Patiala, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC and Sections 409, 201 and 506 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that there is allegation in the FIR that the complainant alongwith other farmers was selling crop to M/s Kishan Chand Sanjeev Kumar and M/s Kishan Chand Rajesh Kumar. But, the

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accused persons failed to disburse huge amount of such agriculture produce, so received from the Government in favour of the concerned farmers, rather they misappropriated the same.

The petitioner has been in custody since 12.02.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
