ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No. 17 dated 03.04.2018, under Sections 307, 452, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. It is further contended that both the injured namely Harpreet Singh @ Happy and Inderjit Singh have fully recovered from their injuries. The petitioner is not required in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 07.05.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and on his doing so, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Palwinder Singh

states that in pursuance to the order dated 07.05.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 07.05.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
