The petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect her life and liberty as she is apprehending threat at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is over 22 years of age and is residing separately from respondent No. 4, who is her father. However, respondent No. 4 has been threatening her as he wants to forcibly get her married against her wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the representation dated 03.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) sent to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana in this regard. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and decide her representation dated 03.05.2018 (Annexure P-1).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the matter and take steps to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
