AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By this petition, FIR No.72 dated 03.10.2014, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Khemkaran, District Tarn Taran, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149 & 34 IPC, is sought to be quashed, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners-accused and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant.

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 22.05.2017, the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patti, has been received, stating therein that the petitioners (accused) Bhupinder Singh, Gurjant Singh alias Janta, Harpreet Singh alias Happy, Jagjit Singh alias Jagga and Pappu, as

also respondent no.2, i.e. complainant, Sardool Singh, appeared before that

Court and recorded their statements to the effect that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

As per the assessment of the learned Magistrate, the compromise arrived at has been without undue influence or any coercion.

That being so and seeing the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners, and petitioner no.4 being the brother of the complainant-respondent no.2, I see no reason to continue with the criminal proceedings against the petitioners, with the matter amicably having been reconciled between them.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.72 dated 03.10.2014, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Khemkaran, District Tarn Taran, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149 & 34 IPC, along with all proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed.
