It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioners are being harassed by respondent No.5 despite they having gone to the Police Station time and again and the enquiry has also been completed and report submitted by Enquiry Officer, Women Cell, B-Division, Amritsar. Counsel also contends that when the petitioners did not approach the Police Station when called upon by respondent No.5, the police authorities are harassing them.

Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with an observation that in case the petitioners are required for any enquiry, a proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be issued and served upon the petitioners. This direction is issued to respondent No.4, who shall ensure the compliance of the provisions of the said Section.
