The petitioners are seeking direction to official respondents to protect their life and liberty as they have been threatened by the private respondents.

It is the case of the petitioners that they had received injuries including amputation of $\frac{3}{4}$ little finger of petitioner No. 1 at the hands of private respondents for which, they had filed an FIR No. 30 dated 28.03.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot. Subsequently Section 326 IPC was added. The private respondents are threatening the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn my attention to the representation dated 28.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) sent to respondent No. 2 in this regard. Learned counsel contends that the petitioners will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide their representation dated 28.04.2018 (Annexure P-

4).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, District Pathankot to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 28.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) and take steps, if necessary, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
