The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 25.01.2018, under Sections 328, 354, 506 and 509 of Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station Chhansa, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends that the petitioner was taken into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 17.02.2018. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is also contended that the entire dispute arises out of a property dispute between the families, while submitting that the investigation in the matter is complete, as the challan has been presented, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to the enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from Investigating Officer, opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner, while submitting that offences

alleged against the petitioner are serious in nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the trial is likely to take some time and in view of the facts the petitioner herein has been in custody since 17.02.2018 and that investigation is complete, as the challan has been presented, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars. At this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
