Status report by way of affidavit of J. Elanchezhian, IPS,
Senior Superintendent of Police Hoshiarpur on behalf of State has
been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482
Cr.P.C. for seeking an appropriate direction to official respondents for
free and fair investigation in case FIR No.31 dated 03.03.2017
(Annexure P-8) under Sections 323, 341, 379, 427, 308, 34 of the
Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Mukertian, District
Hoshiarpur.

Perusal of the status report reveals that after conducting
the investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been
submitted before the Court of Competent Jurisdiction on 29.11.2017.

Learned State counsel further stated that even the charges

have also been framed against the accused by learned trial Court on 19.02.2018.
