By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of cross case, which was registered vide DDR No.33 dated 11.5.2016 under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code in FIR No.37 dated 10.5.2016 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 447, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 31.5.2016, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused and also of the complainant Narinder Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed. It has specifically

been opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and DDR No.33 dated 11.5.2016 under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code in FIR No.37 dated 10.5.2016 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 447, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
