AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Pursuant to the order dated 08.05.2018, learned State counsel on instructions from SI Neelam, submits that virtually no injuries have been recorded in the MLR, a perusal of which also would prima facie atleast seem to indicate that if at all any injuries were sustained by the complainant, they were very simple injuries, (though with the hand writing on the copy of the MLR not being fully decipherable).

In view of the above, without making any comment on the actual culpability or otherwise of the petitioner with regard to the allegations made in the FIR, which would be gone into by the investigating agency, this petition is disposed of with the direction that upon the petitioner joining investigation, if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Illaqa Magistrate.

If the arresting officer does not join the petitioner in investigation, he would appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate immediately, who would then summon the arresting officer and direct him to join him in investigation.
