This is a petition for pre-arrest bail filed by petitioner – Anil Kumar, who has been declared as a proclaimed offender in the case.

In view of the the Apex Court authorities **State of Madhya Pradesh vs. Pradeep Sharma 2014 (2) RCR (Criminal) 269** and **Lavesh vs. State (NCT of Delhi) 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 240,** a proclaimed offender being absconder, in terms of Section 82 Cr.P.C., is not entitled to the pre-arrest bail.

Therefore, the petition stands dismissed.

However, it is observed that in case the petitioner surrenders in the trial Court within 7 days from today, in that event, on his moving an application for regular bail, the same be disposed of by the trial Court expeditiously.
