This is the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0077 dated 19.03.2017 under Section 21-C/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Kalanwali, Distt. Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been involved in the matter on the statement of another co-accused Sewak Singh. However, even that co-accused Sewak Singh has been granted bail by this court. Still further, counsel submits that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. The petitioner does not have any other case of NDPS Act against him.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the bail during the pendency of Trial. He be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bond/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
