Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.210 dated 14.11.2017 under Sections 420/406 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

2.) This Court vide order dated 09.05.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 09.05.2018,

petitioner appeared before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and joined investigation. It is further submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 09.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) The petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
