The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 92 dated 28.06.2016 registered for the offence punishable under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail in terms of order dated 10.05.2018 passed by this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Akshay Kumar endorses the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail, this petition is allowed and order dated 10.05.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan,

subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall keep on appearing before trial Court regularly;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
