In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for direction to the official respondents to serve a 10 days prior notice to the petitioner in terms of Section 41-A Cr.P.C. in case he is required to be arrested in FIR No.65 dated 06.04.2018 registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar under Section 3,4,5 MTP Act 1971, 18, 23, 4 PCPNDT Act, 15(2)(B) Indian Medical Council Act, 420, 120-B IPC.

Having regard to the nature of the relief sought in the present petition, official respondents/concerned respondent is hereby directed to consider the grievance of the petitioner i.e. if petitioner is to be arrested in connection with FIR No.65 dated 06.04.2018 registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar under Section 3,4,5 MTP Act 1971, 18, 23, 4PCPNDT Act, 15(2)(B) Indian Medical Council Act, 420, 120-B IPC, in that event, necessary notice be issued to him under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and thereafter proceed in accordance with law.
