Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 13.02.2018 under Section 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines (Annexure P-1).

2.) This Court vide order dated 31.05.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest the arresting officer/Illaqa Magistrate, on doing so, she was ordered to be released on interim bail on her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Illaqa Magistrate.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sahib Ram states that in pursuance to the order dated 31.05.2018 petitioner appeared before the arresting officer/Illaqa Magistrate on 11.06.2018 and joined the investigation. That apart observations made by this court in the order dated

31.05.2018 have gone unrebutted. Even the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 31.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

5.) The petition stands allowed.
