Petitioner Jagsir Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.30 dated 02.03.2018, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur, under Sections 458, 323, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record I find that the injuries on the persons of complainant and his family members are simple in nature, which fall under Section 323 IPC. As per the allegation, the accused entered the house of the complainant forcibly at about 8:30 P.M.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 08.06.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not

required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 08.06.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
