Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.15 dated 18.01.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 14.05.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a minor aged about 17 and half years. The police, during the investigation, has added Section 326 IPC, as injury No.1 was found to be grievous in nature and the same is attributed to Ravinder Singh @ Laddi, who has been arrested by the police.

Notice of motion for 24.08.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order dated 14.05.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
