The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.39 dated 23.03.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 427, 326 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later) at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a compromise has already been effected between the parties and the petition i.e. Criminal Misc.No.M-17084 of 2018 for quashing of said FIR on the basis of compromise has already been filed before this Court which is still pending. He has further submitted that co-accused have already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 04.05.2018, passed in Criminal Misc.No.M-18024 of 2018.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands allowed. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer. On

doing so, he shall be released on anticipatory bail, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall loose the benefit of anticipatory bail allowed to him.
