FIR No. 134 dated 24.04.2018 was registered at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad under Sections 323, 324, 34, 341, 506 IPC against the private respondents. The petitioner is complainant as well as the injured person. The private respondents were arrested on 01.05.2018 and were granted regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 02.05.2018.

Aggrieved by the order of bail aforementioned, the petitioner has approached this Court.

Learned State counsel as well counsel representing respondents No. 2 and 3 submit that injuries inflicted upon the petitioner are simple in nature. The investigation of the case is complete and till date there is no allegation that respondents No. 2 and 3 have tried to misuse the concession of bail by interfering in the investigation or by tampering with any evidence.

In view of the above, I do not see any reason to cancel the bail granted by the trial Court. The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
