Joint power of attorney on behalf of respondents No. 5 and 6 as well as separate Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondent No. 7, are taken on record. Office to tag the same at the appropriate places.

In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take suitable legal action in accordance with law, on the complaint of petitioner against respondents No. 5 to 7 and to get the same enquired from some investigating agency other than police of Police Station Sadar, Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if, respondent No. 3-Senior

Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, is directed to decide representation dated 15.01.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation Annexure P-2, moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
