Pursuant to order dated 18.1.2018, report dated 26.02.2018 of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur has been received. According to this report, the complainant-respondent No.2 has got his statement recorded to the effect that the compromise is genuine and has been reached without any threat or coercion. The statement of the petitioner could not be recorded as in the document of identification, his name is recorded as Kulbir Singh s/o Sh. Gurmej Singh whereas in the FIR as well as in the petition it is mentioned as Kulbir Singh s/o Sh. Gurmeet Singh.

Be that as it may, since the complainant is satisfied, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the FIR alive.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.47 dated

20.03.2017 registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
