[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioners seek for being released on anticipatory bail in case FIR No.20, dated 03.06.2017, under Sections 379-B and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, District Batala. They were already on bail but could not appear on 22.03.2018 on account of which, their bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest were ordered to be issued against them.

[4]. Their explanation in this regard is that they had by mistake noted the date as being 22nd April, 2018, and as such their absence was unintentional.

[5]. In view of the aforesaid grounds made out in the petition, the matter is disposed off with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within seven days after which they may be released on fresh

bail.

[6]. This order shall automatically stand vacated after 17.05.2018.
