These are two petitions filed by Satish @ Bhola and Vijay seeking regular bail in case FIR No.682 dated 29.12.2017 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 150, 448, 365, 354, 307, 506, 120-B of IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Model Town, Rewari later converted only under Sections 147, 149, 150, 323, 325, 363, 448, 506, 427 and 120-B of IPC.

This is the second application on behalf of Satish.

A complaint was lodged by Kailashi Devi. The incident took place at 7.30 am when she and her husband was sitting inside their house. The gate was bolted, fifteen/sixteen persons climbed over the gate and entered the house and broke open the door and dragged her out of the house. The complainant tried to free herself. She was forcefully put in a white car and was taken to an unknown place.

The incident was caught in the CCTV camera installed in the house nearby. The allegations against Vijay are that he was driving the car which was hired by Satish. There are call records between Vijay and Satish. They were known to each other. Presence of one of them is noted in the CCTV camera. The complainant had made allegations that she was molested.

CCTV camera pictures were converted into a CD which was played in the Court today. The main accused is yet to be arrested.

The accused in conspiracy with the main accused (who is absconding) had made a daring attempt to evict the complainant from the property. She was put into a car and was taken away and the injuries were inflicted upon her.

Considering the allegations, no case for bail is made out.

Both the petitions are dismissed.
