The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.224 dated 13.8.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 120-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner along with co-accused Binder Singh, Jagsir Singh and Amandeep Singh has caused murder of Gurjit Singh. It is a case of blind murder and based on circumstantial evidence. It is further submitted that the motor cycle has been recovered but the number of the motor cycle has not been mentioned in the FIR. The main witnesses before the learned trial Court have turned hostile. It is further submitted that the co-accused have already been granted bail by this Court.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and

keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Manpreet Singh @ Vilayati son of Major Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
