The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 62 dated 11.03.2018, registered under Section 306 IPC, Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurgaon.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he used to drink a lot and beat his wife. The FIR had been lodged by the son.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that challan has been presented and one witness has been examined and the petitioner is in custody since 19.03.2018. Counsel says that the trial will take time, therefore, bail may be granted.

The trial would take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
