ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.42 dated 22.10.2016 registered under Sections 498-A & 406 IPC at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur, Punjab and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the trial Court after statements of the parties were recorded regarding the compromise. The trial Court has reported that the compromise is voluntary and without any threat or coercion. The trial Court has also sent copies of the statements of the parties.

All the accused are not party to the petition and the husband of the complainant is stated to be abroad.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements and report of the trial Court and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed *qua* the petitioners.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
