Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect/safeguard the life of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8.

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Amritsar City, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has already been filed and in para No.2 of this reply, it is stated that the petitioner had solemnized love marriage in the year 2008 and for this reason, she was disowned from movable and immovable property by her father Vinod Kumar (respondent No.4) and presently she is residing in a separate room in the house of her father alongwith her two minor daughters. It is further stated that the police has looked into the complaint filed by the petitioner and found that petitioner has filed a civil suit against her father which is pending in the Court of Civil Judge, Amritsar and prior to 04.07.2017,

petitioner had never given any application against private respondents. Inasmuch as the petitioner does not require any protection as the matter is regarding share of property from her father-respondent No.4.

Short reply on behalf of respondents No. 4 to 8 has already been filed in which it is stated that the petitioner has performed marriage with one Tajpal Singh and at that time, father of the petitioner had disowned her. The petitioner and her husband-Tajpal Singh with a view to extort money from Vinod (deponent), his family have started the proxy litigation with each other and obtained divorce by mutual understanding on 25.07.2016. They are in regular communication with each other.

In view of the affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Amritsar City, this petition is rendered as infructuous at this stage.

However, it will be open for the petitioner to approach the respondent(s)-police authorities in case she still feels any threat to her life and liberty.
